



Roll-Off Solid Waste Disposal Containers

City of Tracy- Solid Waste Division

This is a Notice to the Users of Roll-Off Solid Waste Disposal Containers regarding excess weight and proper container use.

Customers who use Roll-Off containers for solid waste may have to pay an excess weight charge. The costs at the Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station and County landfills are based on tonnage. The City of Tracy is, therefore, implementing a standard methodology using tonnage in assessing garbage fees when excess weight is loaded into solid waste disposal containers.

Container Size	Weight Allowed	Excess Weight Charge Per Ton
10 YARD	2.20 TONS (GARBAGE)	\$63.00
10 YARD	7.20 TONS (INERTS ONLY)	\$50.00
20 YARD	4.05 TONS	\$63.00
30 YARD	5.95 TONS	\$63.00
40 YARD	7.80 TONS	\$63.00

EXAMPLE: A 10 yard container filled with mixed waste (garbage and inerts) weighing 10 tons would have an excess weight charge of \$491.40 (7.80 tons at \$63.00 per ton). Actual weights will vary, depending on the moisture and density content of the material being loaded into the container.

An exception for inert material: A 10 yard container filled with only inert material, i.e. dirt, concrete, brick, rock, sod, asphalt, tile, or sand, which can be disposed of without taking the material to a County landfill, will be provided an additional 5 ton allowance to 7.20 tons before an excess weight fee will be charged. Inert tons in excess of 7.20 tons will be charged at \$50.00 per ton.

EXAMPLE: A load of inert material weighing 9 tons would have 1.80 tons of excess weight at \$50.00 per ton and would equal \$90.00 in excess weight charges.

NOTE: Loads must not exceed legal weight limit of 10 tons. Customer will be responsible for offloading containers in excess of 10 tons. All loads must be level and not higher than the sides of the container. Customer will be responsible to level loads and/or remove debris that is higher than the sides of the container.

A 10 yard container is the only container authorized for inert material. Larger containers would be too heavy for open roads if filled with inert material. All Hazardous Waste is Prohibited. This includes but is not limited to the following: batteries, light bulbs, paint. For questions regarding proper disposal of hazardous waste call Tracy Disposal Service Company (209)835-0601.

By signing, I acknowledge and agree to the charges and terms stated above. Additionally, I acknowledge that Tracy Disposal Service Company is not responsible for any damages that may occur to the driveway or pathway, due to the weight of the container.
