## What is the "Blue-Bag" Program?

The Blue-Bag Program is a voluntary and simple recycling program available to San Joaquin customers. Residents are encouraged to place all dry, clean recyclables in a special blue plastic bag, provided by Delta Disposal. The bag should be placed inside your garbage can on your normal garbage service day. The recyclables in the blue bag will be collected and processed at the Tracy Material Recovery Facility, located on S. MacArthur Drive.

# What was the Blue-Bag Program chosen over other curbside recycling programs?

The Blue-Bag Program is easier, more convenient and provides for the recycling of more materials and is less expensive than other types of curbside programs that use separate plastic bins. The Blue-Bag Program is well suited to provide recycling in areas where homes are not close together. In addition, this program allows Delta Disposal to use their existing collection vehicle to collect recyclable materials at the same time the garbage is picked up, thus reducing costs and traffic.

No: Dirt, Rock, Liquids, Oil, Gas, Chemicals, Water, Food, Ashes or Coal, Styrofoam Packaging Peanuts, Dead Animals, Hazardous Waste
