



Roll-Off Solid Waste Disposal Containers

Delta Disposal Company- Excess Weight Acknowledgement

This is Notice to the Users of Roll-Off Solid Waste Disposal Containers regarding excess weight and proper container use.

10 YARD CONTAINERS

The base rate for a 10 yard container is \$268.68 and allows 2.2 tons of waste. Weight exceeding 2.2 tons will be charged \$89.00 per ton. An exception is made for inerts. The base rate for a 10 yard container filled with inerts only has a base rate of \$518.68 and allows 7.2 tons of inert material only. Additional tons over 7.2 tons (inerts only) will be charged \$50.00 per ton. * **A 10 yard container is the only container that may be used to dispose dirt, concrete, brick, rock, sod, asphalt, tile, sand or stucco.**

20, 30, 40 YARD CONTAINERS

The current haul rate of \$140.00 per load plus an additional disposal fee of \$89.00 per ton will be charged for container sizes 20 yard, 30 yard and 40 yard.

Container Size	Weight Allowed	Base Rate	Excess Weight Charge Per Ton
10 YARD	2.2 TONS	Base Rate: \$268.68	\$89.00
10 YARD INERTS ONLY	7.2 TONS INERTS ONLY	Base Rate: \$518.68	\$50.00
Container Size	Weight Allowed	Haul Rate	Disposal Fee Per Ton
20 YARD	10.0 TONS	\$140.00 per load	\$89.00
30 YARD	10.0 TONS	\$140.00 per load	\$89.00
40 YARD	10.0 TONS	\$140.00 per load	\$89.00

EXAMPLE: A 10 yard container that is full of dirt, concrete, brick, rock, sod, asphalt, tile, or sand, that is level with the top of the container weighs approximately 10 tons. A 10 yard container weighing 10 tons (inerts only) would incur a charge of \$518.68 plus a material fee of 2.8 tons at \$50.00 per ton; \$518.68 + \$140.00 = \$658.68. Actual weights will vary, depending on the moisture and density content of the material being loaded into the container.

Loads must not exceed legal weight limit of 10 tons. Customer will be responsible for offloading containers in excess of 10 tons. All loads must be level and not higher than the sides of the container. Customer will be responsible to level loads and/or remove debris that is higher than the sides of the container.
